

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. In this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "curb" shall mean the lateral boundaries of a highway, whether or not marked by curbing;
 - (b) "highway" means any public highway within the municipality under the direction, control and management of the municipality and "public highway" means a public highway as defined by The Highways and Transportation Act, 1983-84;
 - (c) "motor vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined by or pursuant to The Highway Traffic Act;
 - (d) "parking" shall mean the standing of a motor vehicle, whether occupied or not, upon a highway, otherwise than temporarily for the purpose of and while actually engaged in loading or unloading, or in obedience to traffic regulations, traffic signs or signals, or the direction of a traffic officer or constable.
2. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control to be parked on any highway, except as may be authorized by this Bylaw.
3. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle under his control to stand unattended on any highway, unless such motor vehicle shall first have been parked in the manner as provided in this bylaw.
4. Subject to the provisions of Section 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 hereof the parking of motor vehicles is hereby permitted on all highways.
5. Pursuant to Section 40 of The Highway Traffic Act, and this bylaw, no persons shall stop or park a motor vehicle on any public highway, outside of a hamlet, within 30 meters of another motor vehicle stopped or parked on the opposite side of the highway.
6.
 - (a) Subject to clause 6(b), no person shall park a motor vehicle on any highway except in the following manner, to wit: such motor vehicle shall be drawn up to the curb on the right hand side of the highway, parallel to the curb and with the right front and rear wheels at a distance not more than thirty centimeters from the curb.
 - (b) Vehicles parking on any portion of a highway or highways specified in Schedule A, attached to and forming part of this bylaw, must draw up to the curb on the right hand side of the highway at an angle of approximately forty-five degrees with the right front wheel at a distance of not more than thirty centimeters from the curb. Every area where angle parking is required shall be designated by the erection and maintenance of suitable signs or markers, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway, showing that angle parking is required.
7. No motor vehicle shall be parked on any highway with the engine running, unless the same is under the control of a licensed operator.
8. No motor vehicle used, designed or intended for the conveyance of inflammable, combustible, explosive or other dangerous materials, whether loaded or unloaded, shall be parked at any time upon a highway except for the sole purpose of, and only for the time necessary to receive or deliver orders.
9. Vehicles are prohibited from parking at any time on any portion of a highway or highways specified in Schedule B attached to and forming part of this bylaw. Every area where parking is so prohibited shall be designated by the erection and maintenance therein of suitable signs or markers, clearly visible from the travelled portion of the highway, showing that parking in such area prohibited.

10. No person shall park a motor vehicle at any time within any area where parking has been prohibited in accordance with Section 8.
11. No person shall deface, injure, destroy or remove any sign or marker erected in accordance with the provisions of this bylaw.
12. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.
