

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF  
VANSCOY #345 HELD ON MONDAY DECEMBER 21<sup>ST</sup> IN THE

Reeve Chapple called the meeting to order at 9:10 AM.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss, the Pike Landfill, Foreman hiring, Bill  
186, Beaudin property, Out of scope wages, Alawa foods, SARM convention and  
building inspectors.

421/05 Junop moved that we hire Scott Loewen as the new Foreman for the RM  
of Vanscoy at a rate of \$85000.00 per year with benefits to be negotiated further  
that there will be a six month probation and if the position doesn't work out Scott  
can return to his old job with the RM with no loss of seniority.

Carried.

422/15 Kool moved that we have Kim Anderson finalize a payment with the  
contractor and material supplier to bring the Beaudin building to the lockup stage  
and if it is completed to the building inspectors satisfaction that we release the  
final payment.

Carried.

423/15 Harvey moved the out of scope employees Denise Ward and Murray  
McCracken receive a 5% increase in wages for 2016 and 4% for 2017. Further,  
that all out of scope employees also receive the long service award that is paid  
annually.

Carried.

424/15 Stevens moved that we appoint Municode Services to do all our building  
inspections, residential, commercial and industrial for 2016, further that they  
follow the City of Saskatoon system of inspections which will include a vapour  
barrier inspection.
