Business Arising from minutes:

Warman RCMP Staff Sgt Thomas attended the December RM Council meeting and answered some tough questions regarding RCMP lack of attendance in the RM and lack of communication with Vanscoy Police Service. Staff Sgt Thomas was invited to attend the next Vanscoy Police Commission meeting.

Sgt Mochoruk attended a meet and greet for the new chief of Corman Park. The attendees discussed some policies and the need for communication amongst the various police services. They plan to meet quarterly.

**2022 Budget** with ALPR purchase was approved by RM Council. Net budget cost \$277,289.00

Junop spoke to SK Police Commissioner in Regina to discuss the cost of the RCMP. The cost of the contract is set down east. The \$53 per capita per year is the cost whether there is a detachment within the municipality or not.

Police Service:

**Budget**

Chief McCracken spoke to timing of revenue. It can take 1 - 2 years for ticket revenue to be received from Sask Justice. Ticket revenue comes from the Vanscoy Police as well as any tickets written in the RM by the RCMP, CP police etc.

Officers ensure all parts of ticket are filled in and/or circled – or the ticket could be dismissed, and revenue will not be received.

**ALPR Update**

Automatic License Plate Reader

Sgt Mochoruk is in the process of completing required forms & questionnaires and obtaining clearance required from traffic prosecutions.

**New Officer**

Officer Travis Holeha was introduced and welcomed.

**Activity**

Completed new RM of Vanscoy Bylaw for the Discharge of Firearms within the RM in November.

Discussion on policing calls and activities within the RM. All reports are entered into RMS /record management system.

333 households/ 649 members

McCracken stressed the importance of keeping Crime Watch going, even though community meetings have been suspended due to Covid. Encourage neighbours to join.
