Discussion on the future need for a new police vehicle – current wait times are much longer than the past and the last Tahoe ordered from Mainline Motors was 6 months until delivery. Suggested that Chief check out prices and expected delivery timelines.

If there is not room when requested the Police Com would have other options (Depot in Regina or out of province) Depot current cost to train a recruit is \$50,000.00
